In recognition of their selfless efforts to promote safety, we are pleased to announce these 2018 District 7 awards.

D7 LIGHTHOUSE AWARD

Initiated in 2018, the Lighthouse Award is a performance based award for recognizing Program Visitors who have performed 1,000 or more program visits during their service in the Auxiliary.

Certificates will be signed by District 7 Commodore and issued quarterly.

Lighthouse certificates will be mailed to the Division Commander for members in his/her AOR with our recommendation for presentation at division meetings.

BRAVO ZULU AWARDS

A performance based district award, Bravo Zulu certificates for Program Visitor completing 50, 100, 250 and 500 or more program visits annually.

Based on calendar year achievements, BZ certificates will be issued in January to Division Commanders with our recommendation for presentation at division or flotilla meetings.

Tracking, monitoring and issuing the Bravo Zulu awards will be completed by DSO-PV and ADSO-PV person in charge of awards. Flotilla Commanders and PV flotilla and division leaders do not have to submit a request for BZ awards.
